Lecture Synopsis

ABUTMENT MODIFICATION TO YIELD AESTHETIC SOFT TISSUE IN ANTERIOR IMPLANT

Anterior single implant restoration yields highly predictable and aesthetically pleasing result in modern dentistry. Immediate provisionalization technique and delayed soft tissue manipulation are often conducted to maintain the architecture of the tissue surrounding the dental implant in the aesthetic zone. Solid comprehension of abutment selection and evaluation of its emergence profile are keys to successful and aesthetically pleasing implant-supported restoration. To yield maximum prosthetically-versatile restoration, a dentist should possess the skill set needed to modify implant abutment and in-depth knowledge of tissue biology and properties of the restoration material.

REMOVABLE PARTIAL DENTURE: UPDATES

Removable partial denture (RPD) is a treatment choice of partially dentate patients, offering a more affordable option to replace missing teeth for patients who cannot afford the fixed and implant supported prosthesis. RPD therapy enables dentists to offer inexpensive treatment alternatives to address patients' aesthetic and masticatory needs. This presentation is intended to provide an update overview of removable partial dentures therapy and evidence based information to help dentists integrate RPD treatment into day-to-day clinical care.

SHIFTING IN PARADIGM OF PROVIDING FULL DENTURES : THE IMPLANT OVERDENTURE

Preventive and conservative dentistry has been the current trend of treatment but we faced with limited treatment option in cases where extraction is strongly indicated. In these cases, demands for full denture are still high. However, problems arise when patient presented with atrophic ridge, where retention of the denture will be compromised. A consensus was published in guiding the clinicians for providing implant overdenture. Literatures revealed that implant overdenture have advantages that outweigh the risk of surgery to patients.

In this lecture, the speaker will discuss the need of prescribing patient with implant overdenture, type of overdenture available and how to prescribe suitable options or design to patients. Due to the fact that implant overdenture is not a new concept, adequate data were available to discuss on the success and failure rate, including complications reported and maintenance needed. By attending this lecture, we hope that clinicians will now have a better understanding and can consider implant overdenture as one of the treatment options, as well as able to convince their patients to opt for this treatment. However, no clinical stages will be discussed in this lecture.
