Dr. Aeman Elkezza, granted BDS from the Benghazi Dental School, Libya (2003), and his postgraduate study in Prosthodontics (2010) from the University of Dundee UK, currently works as a dental lecturer in Department of Restorative Dentistry, University of Malaya. He is a co-founder of Libyan section International Association of Dental Research, member of Asian Academy of Prosthodontics and a registered member of Malaysian Dental Association. His interest is related to removable prosthesis teeth positioning, and evidence based dentistry.

Title and Synopsis

REMOVABLE PARTIAL DENTURE: UPDATES

Removable partial denture (RPD) is a treatment choice of partially dentate patients, offering a more affordable option to replace missing teeth for patients who cannot afford the fixed and implant supported prosthesis. RPD therapy enables dentists to offer inexpensive treatment alternatives to address patients' aesthetic and masticatory needs. This presentation is intended to provide an update overview of removable partial dentures therapy and evidence based information to help dentists integrate RPD treatment into day-to-day clinical care.

Awarded a Tier 5 International Fellowship in the Areas of Special interest on Full mouth rehabilitation in Patients with tooth wear in year 2015/16

Title and Synopsis

Sharing the experience of the Tier 5 International Training Fellowship.

The six-month training experience under supervision of Consultant, Professor Dr Alex Milosevic in Royal Liverpool University Dental Hospitals, Liverpool, United Kingdom, for Full Mouth Rehabilitation of Tooth Wear within Restorative Dentistry was fully sponsored by Training Division Ministry of Health Malaysia. This training was subjected to all the requirements as laid out by the NACPDE UK who helped with the visa requirement and advice.

The full mouth rehabilitation of patients with severely worn dentition with accompanying loss of vertical dimension of occlusion will be presented. The aims of treatment were to restore the aesthetics and improve masticatory function, and it was achieved by composite build up and provision of removable prosthesis. The treatment option had been suggested to be efficient and cost-effective, with the final outcome pleasing to the patients.
